Post-Exam Schedule (Monday, 18 October, to Friday, 29 October 2021)

1. He/she may not share their concerns with you and may mask his/her anxiety with humour. We seek your support to check in on their well-being regularly over these 3 days. Should you need more support from the school, please contact the respective Form Teachers or Year Heads.
4. Learning is a journey and secondary school provides a foundation programme for higher education. Regardless of their current academic performance, we assure you and your child/ward that all students will be able to continue their learning. Our school community stands ready to support their holistic development.
5. In the last week of the term, the school has planned a series of programmes to celebrate the completion of the academic year and enrich the learning of the students. Students will report to school and be dismissed at the usual timings from 25 to 27 October. The last day of the school term is Friday, 29 October and the dismissal time is 10 am.
