Post-Exam Schedule (Monday, 18 October, to Friday, 29 October 2021)

1. As the academic year draws to a close, our school would like to provide more opportunities for your child/ward to experience the joy of learning (see Annex for a summary of the post-exam schedule). 3. The results of the End-of-Year Examination will be progressively released over 3 days (19 to 21 October). The subject teachers will be going through the exam scripts with your child/ward. During this period, your child/ward may struggle with anxiety if they perceive that they have failed to meet your expectations and/or their own academic targets. He/she may not share their concerns with you and may mask his/her anxiety with humour. We seek your support to check in on their well-being regularly over these 3 days. Your encouragement and attention over this week is crucial in safeguarding their mental wellness. Should you need more support from the school, please contact the respective Form Teachers or Year Heads.
4. Learning is a journey and secondary school provides a foundation programme for higher education. Regardless of their current academic performance, we assure you and your child/ward that all students will be able to continue their learning. Our school community stands ready to support their holistic development.
5. In the last week of the term, the school has planned a Bridging Programme for our Sec 3 cohort from 25 to 27 October. This programme allows more time for curriculum recovery due to disruptions brought about by Covid-19. The last day of the school term is Friday, 29 October and the dismissal time is 10 am. The new school year will begin on Tuesday, 4 January 2022.
