Dear Parents/Guardian of MOE FAS students,

To provide added support for all students on MOE FAS during this circuit breaker period, MOE, with support from the Sayang Sayang Fund by the Community Foundation of Singapore (CFS), extends meal subsidies to these students whether or not they return to school during the full home-based learning (HBL) period.

The provision will cover the four weeks of HBL from 8 April to 4 May 2020, and can be used to purchase food and essential groceries at places including some hawker centres, food courts and supermarkets. MOE will credit four weeks of meal subsidies via students' School Smartcard. Secondary school MOE FAS students will receive \$120 each.

The school meal subsidies will be disbursed via two top-ups to the students' School Smartcard, and you can redeem at any TransitLink Add Value Machine once every two weeks starting from Tuesday, 14 April 2020. The School Smartcard can be used to purchase food and essential groceries at some hawker centres, food courts, minimarts, convenience stores and supermarkets. The links are as follows:
